*Shabbat Candle Blessing* — The mitzvah of kindling Shabbat lights in the home is an early rabbinic practice (*M. Shabbat 2:1ff.*) The Shabbat candle blessing is first recorded in the ninth-century prayerbook, *Seder Rav Amram*. Lighting Shabbat candles as part of the synagogue service is an innovation of Reform Judaism.







*Baruch atah Adonai, Eloheinu Melech haolam borei minei v'samim.*



Over the light of the special Havdallah candle (with multiple wicks):

ברוך אתה ייִהוּ אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, בָּרוּךְ מַאֲוִרֵי הַאֲשָׁר.

*Baruch atah Adonai, Eloheinu Melech haolam, borei m'orei ha-eish.*



The final blessing, marking the separation between Shabbat and the rest of the week:
