- Introduction to blessings for lighting Chanukah candles & Four Questions (Ma Nishtana)

# First grade

# Torah

- What a Sefer Torah is and that we keep the Sefer Torah in the Aron (ark)
- Basic Torah stories

# **Holidays**

- Stories of each holiday
- What are the special things we do on each holiday?
- Shabbat is a special day

# Israel

- Symbols of Israel (the Israeli flag, the Kotel, the menorah)
- Israel is our Jewish homeland.

# Hebrew

Familiarity with some Hebrew letters and the sounds they make

#### Recitation

- Familiarity with the Shabbat blessings over wine, challah, and candles
- Introduction to blessings for lighting Chanukah candles & Four Questions (Ma Nishtana)

#### Other

Familiarity with objects found in a synagogue (Aron, ner tamid, bimah)

# Second grade

# Torah

- Familiarity with people and stories
- The Torah speaks to each of us and helps us know how to behave
- What a Sefer Torah is and that we keep in the aron (ark)

# **Holidays**

Basic understanding of each holiday and how we celebrate them

#### Israel

- It is our Jewish homeland
- How Jewish holidays are connected to and celebrated in Israel

#### Hebrew

- Hebrew is the Jewish language, the language of the Torah and Israel
- Recognition of the letters and the sounds they make

#### Recitation

- Ability to say or sing the blessings over wine, Shabbat candles, and challah
- Familiarity with the blessings for lighting Chanukah candles and ability to sing the first blessing. Familiarity with the Four Questions (Ma Nishtana) and ability to sing the first two.

# Third grade

#### Torah

- What a Sefer Torah is, that we keep it in the aron (ark), what the ner tamid is
- There are five books in the Torah
- Familiarity with the stories and people in the Torah

#### Holidays

- What is the story of each holiday?
- Basic practices and customs
- What are the special objects we use on each holiday?

# Israel

- It is our Jewish homeland with roots in the Torah
- Hebrew is spoken in Israel
- Introduction to basic geography: major cities and regions (Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, the Negev, Eilat, Haifa) and bodies of water (Dead Sea, Kinneret, Mediterranean)

## Hebrew

- Mastery of letters and vowels
- Ability to read blends (two letters and a vowel)

## Recitation

- Fluency in recitation or singing of Shabbat blessings over candles, wine, and challah
- Ability to sing blessings for lighting candles on Chanukah
- Ability to sing the Four Questions (Ma Nishtana)

# Fourth grade

# Torah

- What is a Sefer Torah? What is an aron?
- How many books are in the Torah? What are their names?
- Understand Torah stories through the lens of relationships (What are the relationships between different people in the Torah like and what do they teach us?)

# **Holidays**

- What are the stories, customs, and ritual objects for each holiday?
- Blessings connected with holidays

## Israel

- Above (the Jewish homeland, Hebrew is spoken there, basic geography)
- What's cool about Israel? Music, technology, Hebrew, cool places to visit

# Recitation

- Ability to recite or sing Shabbat blessings over candles, wine and challah, to sing blessings for lighting candles on Chanukah, Ma Nishtana, and the Shema.
- Familiarity with V'ahavta

# Fifth grade

## Torah

- How many books are in the Torah and what are their names?
- Know Torah stories through the lens of Jewish values (What do the Torah stories teach us about the kind of people we should try to be?)

# **Holidays**

- What are the stories, customs, ritual objects, and blessings connected with each holiday?
- Mitzvot and middot (values) connected to each holiday

#### Israel

- Israel is the Jewish homeland with roots in the Torah, basic geography (major cities and regions)
- Israel is a democracy and what the Knesset is

## Recitation

- Fluency reading and chanting Shabbat blessings, blessings for lighting Chanukah candles, Ma Nishtana, and the Shema
- Increased facility chanting V'ahavta

# 6<sup>th</sup> grade

## Torah

- What's a chumash? What's a parasha?
- Names of the five books in the Torah
- Understand Torah stories through the lens of character traits (leadership, kindness, etc.)

# **Holidays**

- What are the stories, customs, ritual objects, blessings, and mitzvot connected with each holiday? Big review!
- Historical and global context: where did this holiday come from and how is it celebrated around the world?

## Israel

- Israel is the Jewish homeland, basic geography
- Israel's diversity and how it got that way: immigration (aliyot)

# Recitation

- Fluency reading and chanting Shabbat blessings, blessings for lighting Chanukah candles, and the Shema
- Ability to chant V'ahavta and the Torah blessings
- Familiarity with the Amidah (Avot/Imahot, G'vurot)
